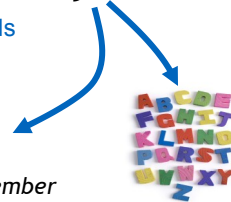

Language & Literacy



- *Mastery of all Language & Literacy Goals for August–December*
- Recognizes all upper and lower case letters 1.1.2
- Follows simple and multiple step directions 15.2.1
- Identifies sight words 1.1.2
- Recognizes a word as a unit of print, that letters are grouped to form words, that words form sentences, and that words are separated by spaces 1.1.2
- Recognizes some conventions of print; capital, period, question mark 1.1.2
- Identifies initial sounds in words 1.1.2
- Segments onset and rime of words 1.1.2
- Understands that writing serves a variety of purposes 1.4.2
- Uses letter-like forms, letters, or random letter strings to express ideas 1.5.3
- Explores letter sound associations while writing 1.4.1
- Demonstrates understanding that technology can be used to gain information 1.9.1

Fine Motor

- Writes all upper case and lower case letters 10.5.3
- Handles and cuts with scissors with developing accuracy 10.5.1

Math

- Uses ordinal words to describe positions of objects (first, second...) 2.1.3
- Uses language to compare number of objects with greater than, less than and equal to 2.6.3
- Represents equivalent forms of the same number with concrete objects 2.2.2
- Represents quantity using invented forms (tally marks) 2.6.1
- Recognizes symmetry 2.9.2
- Orders objects by size and height 2.3.4
- Understands comparisons such as big, bigger, biggest; dark, darker... 2.3.4
- Continues to develop rote counting skills 2.1.1
- Labels sets with numeral (0-20) 2.1.3
- Groups objects into equal groups 2.1.3
